

# Prince of Songkla University Announcement New International Student Preparation Procedures for Academic Year 2019

Students who have been accepted to PSU need to report and register to be considered a PSU student, otherwise their student status will not be considered complete. In case the student cannot report in time, a written notification to the university is needed within seven days from the due date of self-report, otherwise it will be considered a withdrawal from the current semester. Students who do not report within 30 days from the due date will not be eligible to be a student of PSU. All eligible students must go through the procedures listed below:

# 1. Document preparation and self-report information

- 1.1 Check the Student ID on the website: http://www.reg.psu.ac.th
- 1.2 Provide information in the student database at

http://www.psu1-2.psu.ac.th/PSU1-2/ and upload the following document files through the system (SE-DOC) at http://regfile.psu.ac.th/student:

- Photo of student (undergraduates in student uniform, graduate students in black, gray or navy blue suit), without hat or glasses. Veil is allowed; it should be white for undergraduate students, while for graduate students it should be white or identical to the suit's color.
  - Passport main page
  - A certified, complete academic transcript

After providing data in the database and uploading the required documents, the report will be issued within 2 days. Uploading the self-report documents scheduled as follows:
