



## **Agreement for Educational and Scientific Cooperation**

**between**

**Faculty of Agriculture and Animal Science**

**University of Muhammadiyah Malang, Indonesia**

**and**

**Faculty of Natural Resources**

**Prince of Songkla University, Thailand**

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote educational and research opportunities between the two institutions, the Faculty of Agriculture and Animal Science, University of Muhammadiyah Malang, Indonesia (FPP-UMM), and the Faculty of Natural Resources, Prince of Songkla University, Thailand (FNR-PSU) join in the following understanding on educational cooperation and agree on the following principles under which the two institutions may develop activities of mutual interest.

### **Article 1**

Both FPP-UMM and FNR-PSU will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their faculty members and departments, as possible, and will act as coordinators of contacts with other faculties whenever appropriate.

Within fields of mutual collaboration, a general form of cooperation is envisaged as follows:

- (a) Joint research activities,
- (b) Exchange of information in the area of scientific education and research, which is of mutual interest to both of FPP-UMM and FNR-PSU,
- (c) Exchange of faculty members for research, lectures, and discussions,
- (d) Exchange of graduate and undergraduate students for study and research,
- (e) Access to various facilities of each institute.

### **Article 2**

The themes of the joint activities and the conditions for utilizing the results achieved, as well as arrangements for specific visits, exchanges, and other forms of cooperation will

be negotiated for each specific case whenever necessary in accordance with mutual requirements.

Both FPP-UMM and FNR-PSU understand that the financial arrangements will be negotiated at each time and will depend on the availability of funds.

#### Article 3

Exchange staff and/or students will be required to purchase health insurance and casualty insurance or give evidence that they have comparable insurance coverage. In either case, medical evacuation and repatriation coverage must be included.

#### Article 4

This agreement will go into effect from the date of signing by the representatives of both institutions. This agreement is valid for a period of five (5) years following its date of last signature. The validity of the agreement may be extended after mutual consultation.

#### Article 5

For the dissolution of the agreement before its expiry date, it is necessary for one university to provide not less than six months' prior notice in writing to the other.

#### Article 6

If any question arises in this agreement, both universities should resolve it by mutual agreement.

#### Article 7

The agreement shall be written in English in two (2) copies and each party will hold one original copy.


Hereupon, the signature of the representatives of FPP-UMM and FNR-PSU will follow, with the vision of promoting mutual friendship and goodwill.
